However, improper lens care can cause redness and itch to our eyes. Imagine this dream scenario turned into a nightmare: you lock eyes with a cute guy across a crowded room — only to scare him away with your puffy, bloodshot eyes. Heaven forbid!

However, contact lenses are ultimately medical devices for the eyes, and need to be cared for and managed properly."

He adds: "Rubbing and rinsing is advocated by eyecare professionals as an important step in safe lens wear. Rubbing, which takes no more than a few seconds, is instrumental in preventing eye infections."



Q3. I have sensitive eyes, I'm afraid COMPLETE™ Easy Rub™ may not be suitable for me.

Proper lens care isn't that difficult. It only takes five easy steps!

step 1

Wash your hands with soap and water, and dry them with a clean towel before handling your contact lenses.



step 2

Using the middle finger of your dominant hand, gently pull your lower eyelid downwards. Then, take out your lens by gently pinching it between your index finger and thumb.



step 3

Wet your lens with three drops or more of COMPLETE™ Easy Rub™ Multi-Purpose Solution, then gently rub your lens from the centre to the edges for at least 10 seconds. Never rub in a circular motion, because it may tear the lens and not clean the outer edge.



step 4

Rinse both sides of your lens for at least five seconds with COMPLETE™ Easy Rub™ Multi-Purpose Solution.



step 5

Store your lens in a clean case filled with fresh COMPLETE™ Easy Rub™ Multi-Purpose Solution. Allow them to soak for at least six hours, and remember to replace your storage cases at least once every three months to ensure cleanliness.



Here are five basic rules for contact lens care. Remember them well and share them with all your friends!

Before handling lenses or lens cases, always wash your hands with perfume-free soap and dry them with a lint-free cloth.

Use COMPLETE™ Easy Rub™ to carry out the Rub & Rinse regimen. Contact lenses can be stored in unopened lens cases containing COMPLETE™ solution for up to 30 days, after which, the Rub, Rinse and Soak regimen must be repeated prior to wear.

It is important to keep the contact lens cases clean and air-dry them after use.

Never recycle used solution by mixing it with fresh solution or reusing it.

Never use water to store, clean or rinse your lenses, and avoid getting water directly into your eyes, on the lenses as well as in the lens case.
